#### **RESOLUTION 22-26**

**WHEREAS**, the Board of Supervisors, hereafter referred to as "the Board", believes the Bridge Replacement, hereafter referred to as "the project" is in the best interest of Boone County, Iowa, and the residents thereof. The project is defined as Bridge Replacement on X. Ave, over Onion Creek; and **WHEREAS**, the Board has sought appropriate professional guidance for the concept and planning for the project and followed the steps as required by the Code of Iowa fornotifications, hearings, andbidding/letting; and

**WHEREAS,** The Board finds this resolution appropriate and necessary to protect, preserve, and improve the rights, privileges, property, peace, safety, health, welfare, comfort, and convenience of Boone County and its citizens, all as provided for in and permitted by section 331.301 of the Code of Iowa; and

**IT IS THEREFORE RESOLVED** by Board to accept the bid from Herberger Construction Co., Inc. in the amount of \$548,128.70 and awards the associated contract(s) to the same;

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that all other resolutions or parts of resolutions in conflict with this resolution are hereby repealed. If any part of this resolution is adjudged invalid or unconstitutional, such adjudication shall not affect the validity of the resolution or action of The Board as a whole or any part thereof not adjudged invalid or unconstitutional. This resolution shall be in full force and effect from and after the date of its approval as providedby law; and

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** by the Board of Supervisors of Boone County, Iowa, that after receiving the necessary contract documents, including but not limited to, the contractor's bond and certificate of insurance, Nathan Ross, the Assistant County Engineer for Boone County, Iowa, be and is hereby designated, authorized, and empowered on behalf of the Board of Supervisors of said County to execute the contracts in connection with the afore awarded construction project let through the DOT for this county.

Leon Wuebker was present to discuss Drainage Concerns.

Vicious Animal Hearing Pursuant to Boone County Ordinance 36 Section 7 was held, with the following in attendance- Matt Speers, County Attorney, Vanessa Heenan, Humane Society, Erica & Jesse Peterson (dog owners), Katherine Flickinger (Peterson's attorney), Nicole Kennedy (victim), Nathan Lease (witness).

Zinnel moved Kretzinger seconded motion to adopt Resolution 22-27, the dog in question deemed as vicious and ordered to euthanize within 20 days of findings or file for an appeal. All ayes. Motion carried.

#### **RESOLUTION NO. 22-27**

**WHEREAS**, on September 28, 2022, the Board of Supervisors of Boone County conducted a hearing as to whether or not an Australian Shephard dog, owned by Erika Peterson, falls within the Boone County Ordinance Chapter 36, as a "vicious animal."

**WHEREAS,** prior to the hearing Ms. Peterson was served with appropriate notice under the Ordinance Ch. 36, Sec. 7;

WHEREAS, the Board finds the facts as follows:

On or about September 12, 2022, an Australian Shepherd dog was running at large on the property of Erika Peterson at 550 Q Ave., Boone County, Iowa. Nicole Kennedy was lawfully on the property to deliver a package. That the dog, bit or attacked Nicole Kennedy and was not provoked while the dog was running at large. The bite and/or attack caused Nicole Kennedy injuries.

**WHEREAS**, based on the facts presented, the Board finds that the dog meets the Ordinance definitions of "Dangerous Animal" pursuant to Ordinance 36, Section 2, Sub.3 and the definition of "Vicious Animal" pursuant to Ordinance 36, Section 2, Sub. 8.

WHEREAS, the Boone County Board of Supervisors ORDERS as follows:

- 1. That Erika Peterson is ordered to euthanize the identified dog, Australian Shephard that bit or attacked Nicole Kennedy on or about September 12, 2022, in the County of Boone.
- 2. If Erika Peterson refused to cause the animal to be euthanized she shall permit the County to do so.
- 3. Erika Peterson has 20 days from the date of service of this Resolution upon her, to appeal the Board's decision to the Iowa District Court for Boone County.
- 4. That, if after 20 days from the date of service of this Resolution upon Erika Peterson, if no appeal is filed, an animal control officer is authorized to seize and euthanize the animal without further order or resolution of this Board.
- 5. That, during the pendency of any appeal or until such time as the animal is euthanized, Erika Peterson is ordered to secure the animal in a structure or fixed enclosure at all times.

**WHEREAS,** the Board adopted this Resolution on this date and provided a copy to Erika Peterson, satisfying the service of notice requirement.

Adopted by the BOONE County Board of Supervisors this 28th day of September, 2022.

Kretzinger moved Zinnel seconded motion to adjourn the meeting. All ayes. Motion carried. Duffy adjourned the meeting at 12:30 p.m. Approved this  $5^{th}$  day of October, 2022.
