ORDINANCE NO. 72

ORDINANCE DEFINING THE SMALL COMMUNITY ACTION RESOURCE FUND PROGRAM

An ordinance establishing funds for the small (population under 500) incorporated areas of Boone County, Iowa, and providing for the administration, enforcement and amendment thereof.

WHEREAS, the Boone County Health and Sanitation Department desires to establish a program to fund environmental projects, for the purpose of eliminating or improving nuisances on properties within incorporated cities of Boone County, and

WHEREAS, the title of the program shall be known as the Small Community Action Resource Fund, SCARF, and

WHEREAS, a draft of the proposal has been reviewed and refined by the Boone County Board of Health at the January 11, 2006 meeting, and

WHEREAS, Chapter 137, Code of Iowa, empowers the Board of Health to approve and recommend the implementation of an ordinance, for the purpose of promoting the health, safety, and general welfare of the County, to the Board of Supervisors to enact, and

WHEREAS, Chapter 331.302, Code of Iowa, empowers the Board of Supervisors to enact an ordinance and to provide for the administration, enforcement and amendment, and

WHEREAS, The Boone County Supervisors may, by resolution, adopt the **SCARF Manual** to establish procedures and policies in execution of the SCARF program. The rules, regulations and standards for the SCARF Program shall be included in the manual. Copies of the manual shall be available in the Boone County Planning and Development Department; NOW THEREFORE,

**BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF
BOONE COUNTY, IOWA AS FOLLOWS:**

SECTION ONE: That Boone County shall, and it does hereby, approve an ordinance enacting the Small Community Action Resource Fund (SCARF) Program. *(see SCARF Manual for details)*

SECTION TWO: That this amendment shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval in the manner provided by law.
