Chair Jordan officially called the meeting to order at 6:00 pm.

Hagan made a motion to approve the agenda, 2nd by Moe. Motion passed.

Motion to approve the minutes of the previous meeting made by Stotts, seconded by Hagan. Motion passed.

Ex. Dir. Healy presented the monthly bills. Many expenses related to irrigation on golf course. Motion made by Hagan to approve the bills, seconded by Stotts. Passed.

Old Business

Club house update. Waiting on county attorney for guidance on bidding process and next steps. Will meet with this month to have discussion at next meeting.

New Business

Spillway incident. Katie gave an update on the spillway accident on Tuesday, August 2nd. Car, driving at high rate of speed, went off spillway all the way to the bottom. Driver and passenger both injured. Drive was impaired and was taken to jail. Waterline was severed and was fixed by Danny Rodgers. Working with drivers insurance to cover expense. DNR investigated for leaks from vehicle into stream and found no issues. Working on new railing and inspections.

Cooper Sanor gave an update on issues and repairs at golf course. Full 3-page extensive update on all repairs that last few months. Many issues related to irrigation. Learning on the go and making improvements. Moe discussed getting consulting company to look at irrigation system and get list of fixes. Cooper agreed and appreciated all the help and support from Randy Johnson and other individuals at surrounding golf courses.

Open discussion. Looking at getting some signs updated that have been shot up or look bad. Many trees to cut down due to ash bore. Will take systematic approach.

Approximately 15 individuals in attendance. Question on golf course and condition. Many concerns on amount of time spent mowing and maintenance. Cooper explained he has law enforcement training 2 days a week so is working other 3 at the course. Discussion on course condition for large group of that came in. Was not able to mow due to irrigation issues. Many issues related to irrigation issues and taking time away from course mowing.

Motion to adjourn by Moe, 2nd by Sotts. Passed. Meeting adjourned at 7:22pm.
