Kretzinger moved Longhorn seconded motion to approve of Boone County Landfill & Recycling FY26 Budget with the following changes: Landfill Administrator salary with a 3.5% COL + \$2500 and Administrative Assistant salary a 3.5% COL. All ayes. Motion carried.

Longhorn moved Kretzinger seconded motion to setting May 14, 21 & 28, 2025 at 10:00 a.m. as Public Hearing Dates and Times for Ordinance #166, Rezoning Request from C-1(General Commercial) to I-1 (Industrial District) for United Equipment Accessories, Inc. located at 2176 232nd Ln, Ames. All ayes. Motion carried.

Richey Thongvanh, Mental Health Advocate gave a Review on Upcoming Advocate Job Changes for next fiscal year.
