He said that 6-7 contractors attended the meeting asking good questions. He also said that plans for the septic system for the clubhouse have been modified to include a sand filter. Due dates for the bids are May 21st at 1pm at the courthouse.



Other discussions were expressed from the public about a new women's league. It was suggested that a reduced price be offered, The board deferred on the issue.


Chris Call, Swede Point Park Ranger, attended the meeting to discuss a proposal from the Army Corp of Engineers to assume responsibility for the boat ramp by Highway 210. It is need of many repairs and has become an area of ATV's and dumping activity. It would require more man power to supervise, thus the board asked that Chris to inquire about compensation for the extra work needed.

The staff said that the campground policy is a little ambiguous about staying 14 days within a 28 day period. The staff will prepare an amendment to the policy clarifying our intentions for camping.
