Longhorn moved Bryant seconded motion to approve to designate the regular meeting days of the Board of Supervisors as the first business day in January and the first business day in July and every Wednesday, starting at 9:00 a.m. for regular session. Bryant moved Longhorn seconded the motion stating the Boone County Board of Supervisors hereby approve the attendance at duly called and authorized County Officer's School of Instruction by District, State, and I.S.A.C. officials, give the authority for all officers and the personnel of elected and appointed officials with the courthouse and county departments, to attend aforesaid meeting, and upon their presentation of duly authenticated claims and with proper verification thereof for attendance of aforesaid meetings, will be reimbursed for expenses incurred, plus mileage at \$.67 cents per mile. Longhorn moved Bryant seconded the motion to authorize County Auditor to issue, in advance of regular board sessions, warrants for claims presented for payment on demand and biweekly payrolls of the various county offices and departments, it is now being authorized by the Boone County Board of Supervisors to approve this action by the County Auditor for the year 2026 when approved certification by each department head of the county is given to the Auditor. All payroll checks for county personnel will be issued on Friday following the end of the pay period, any other payroll checks issued outside a regular pay period will be paid with approved certification by the department head.
