County Road Naming System

- I. County Roads that run generally in a North-South direction are called "Avenues" and the section line roads are named with letters of the alphabet beginning at the County Line Road on the West. The West County Line Road is A Ave and the East County Line Road is Y Ave. For the County Roads that do not fall generally on the section line they are named with a name starting with the letter of the alphabet that the west section line road is. If possible the name will be the name of a animal, flower or tree. If it is not feasible to follow this naming procedure the Administrator will select an appropriate name. An example would be in Dodge township Section 9 the 1/2 section line road is called Orchid Ave.
  
- II. County Roads that run generally in a East-West direction are called "Streets" and are named numerically starting with the North County Line Road. The North County line Road is 100TH ST and the South County Line Road 340TH St. All section line Roads are numbered in even tens. Those roads that do not generally follow the section line are numbered so as to indicate the distance from the section line. As an example the road that is one half mile South of the North County Line is 105TH ST.
  
- III. County Roads that run some what diagonally or curve with in a section are called "Roads". They are named either numerically or alphabetically depending on which way they generally run. An example of this is the West River Road in Pilot Mound Township is called Juniper Rd.
  
- IV. County Roads that curve and go from East-West to North-South are called Drives. They are named by either identifying their starting or ending locations in the same order as Streets and Avenues. An example of this is in West Dodge Township, the road that goes from Nature Road North of Ridgeport to 130TH ST East of the River is 114TH DR.
  
- V. County Roads that are less than one mile in length and are dead ends will be called "Lanes". They will be named in the same order as the Streets and Avenues. An example of this is in Section 8 and 9 of Pilot Mound township. The road that runs west from I Ave 1/2 mile north of 120TH St is 115Th LN.

- VI. State and US Highways will be named in the same manner as the other County Roads.
- VII. Private Roads in development areas are called "Place" and named in the same order as the Streets and Avenues. An example of this would be in Yell Township Section 35, Knob Hill East road would be 215TH Pl.

Property Numbering.

- I. All property numbering will start at the North-West Corner of th County. Both the East-West Streets and the North-South Avenues will start with 000 at the County line.
- II. The last two digits of the property number will indicate the distance form either the north or west section line. Even numbers are on the East and South side.
- III. An example is in section 6 Grant Township the home on the East side of A Ave and approximately 1/2 mile south of 100TH ST, address is 44 A AVE. The home on the South side of 100TH ST almost to B Ave, address is 94 100TH ST.

Sign Location

- I. Street, Avenue, Road, Drive, Lane and Place signs are placed in the North-West corner of the intersection on the right-of-way line when possible. If not possible the Administrator will determine the location.
- II. Property signs are placed on the left hand side of the main entrance to the property on the property/right-of-way line. If this is not practical the Administrator will determine the location.
- III. All signs will be of a color and style as prescribed by the County.
