



REQUEST FOR TEMPORARY RESTRICTED LICENSE - OWI REVOCATION

To request a temporary restricted license (TRL) for an operating while intoxicated (OWI) offense only, please complete this form and submit it to Driver & Identification Services. You may submit the form by any of the following methods:

- **By personal delivery** to any Driver & Identification service center. You can find all our service center locations on the web at <https://iowadot.gov/mvd/iowa-dot-locations>.

Prior to issuance of a TRL, you must do the following:

- **Provide a Certificate of Installation of an approved ignition interlock device (IID) in all vehicles you own or will operate.** A listing of approved IID providers can be found at www.iowadot.gov/mvd/driverslicense/suspensions-and-revocations.
- **Provide proof of financial responsibility (SR-22) insurance.** Your insurer will issue form SR-22, which is a certificate that proves you have the required coverage.
- **Pay any required civil penalties.** The OWI revocation triggers a \$200 civil penalty that you must pay before you can reinstate your driving privileges. You can pay that when you go to the service center, or you can pay it online at <https://iowadot.gov/mvd/online-services>. If you have other outstanding civil penalties, you must also pay those.

Sobriety and drug monitoring program. If your OWI offense occurred in a county or city that conducts a sobriety and drug monitoring program under chapter 901D of the Iowa Code, you may be required to participate in a sobriety and drug monitoring program to get and keep a TRL.

Under age 21 offenders and commercial vehicle operators not eligible. You are not eligible for a TRL if your license was revoked because you were under age 21 and you had a test result of two hundredths (0.02) but less than eight hundredths (0.08). You are also not eligible if you operate a vehicle that requires a commercial driver license (CDL) to operate.

What you can do with a temporary restricted license. There are no restrictions on where you may operate your vehicle in the state of Iowa provided you remain compliant with the ignition interlock requirements required by Iowa Code chapter 321J.

CAUTION: Once your OWI revocation has become effective, you are not legally allowed to drive unless and until we have given you permission to do so by approving and issuing to you a TRL. Submitting this application does not authorize you to drive until you have appeared at a service center, passed required exams and been issued the license.
